

Cranmer Hall Internal Bursaries

Cranmer Means Tested Undergraduate Bursary

Purpose: To promote recruitment to the FCT and CUG tracks.

Eligibility: Independent or Free Church Track students studying at undergraduate level xxxx course. Students in receipt of Student Finance or the Staff/Spouse bursary are not eligible for the CMTB.

Process: Students are required to complete a 'Cranmer Hall Means Tested Undergraduate Bursary' form by the deadline of 31st August. Applications will then be considered at a meeting of the 'Cranmer Hall Means Tested Undergraduate Bursary Panel' who will in turn inform applicants no later than two weeks prior to the commencement of the academic year.

Cranmer Diocese Bursary

Purpose: To encourage and support individuals involved in local ministry and to strengthen relationships between Cranmer and the sending institutions.

Eligibility: This is a discretionary bursary and would cover Ministry Experience Volunteer students in local churches looking to undertake study and Durham Diocese clergy undertaking CMD by studying modules from the BA and MA programmes. Generally this will be decided on a cohort rather than individual basis with the agreement of CHOs.

Process: Following agreement of CHOs this will be automatically applied to all relevant students.

Staff / Spouse Bursary

Purpose: To develop the learning community at Cranmer.

Eligibility: Bursary for staff, staff spouses and student spouses wishing to undertake study.

Process: Automatically applied.

Cranmer Ministry Bursary

Purpose: To encourage further theological study amongst those involved in ministry.

Eligibility: Bursary for practicing ministers looking to undertake further professional personal development. This is not exclusively for ordained Church of England ministers, but could include Church of England Laity involved in ministry and ministers of independent churches.

Process: Ministry involvement form,

Alumni – Supply copy of certificate or transcript

Cranmer International Bursary

Purpose: To develop the international nature of the Cranmer Hall community and to create opportunities for study at Cranmer, who otherwise would not be able to because of economic hardship by bringing the international fees in line with domestic fees.

Eligibility: Students coming from majority or international world contexts wishing to undertake full or part time undergraduate or postgraduate study.

Process: Letter and Means Tested Applied by Admissions Secretary upon provision of evidence of nationality. Discretionary cases referred to CHOs.
